The LAMS competence editor allows Authors to create learning competencies within a learning design, and the map them to specific activities in a LAMS sequence.

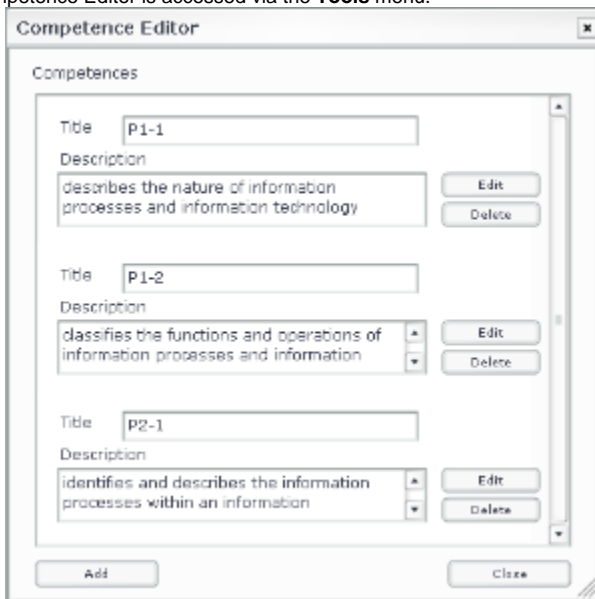

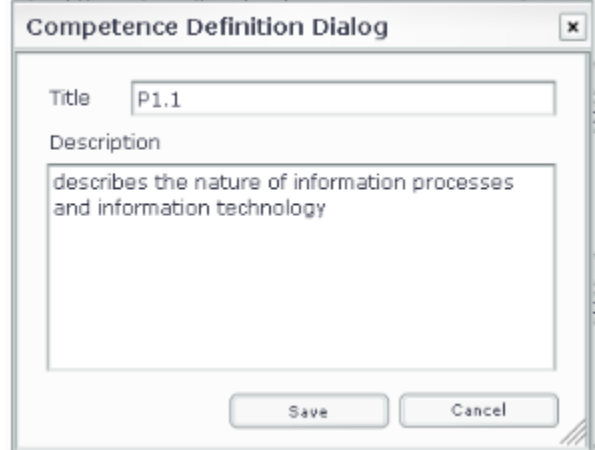
## Creating and Using Competencies (Authoring Environment)

To use Competencies in a LAMS sequence, the individual competencies must first be created using the Competence Editor.

- The Competence Editor is accessed via the **Tools** menu.

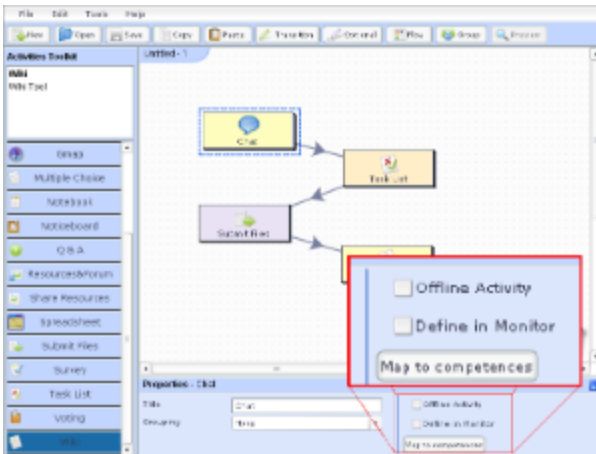


Select **Tools > Competence Editor**

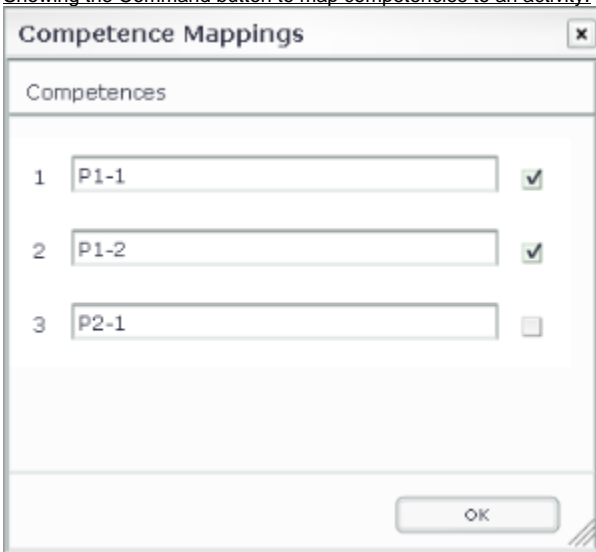


- Here you can create individual competencies based on what the sequence sets out to achieve. This example uses the outcomes from the the NSW IPT Stage 6 Syllabus to demonstrate.

Once the Competencies have been created, you can map competencies to individual activities in the sequence.
