Docjar plugin

A handy Eclipse plugin to search Java API docs.

With it, you can search Java API doc within Eclipse. Source code is associated with the javadoc and ready to view or download.

Just extract the little docjar-1.0.zip to your Eclipse root folder(for example, d:/eclipse) and restart Eclipse, and then follow the menu path: Windows->show view->others->DocJar->DocJar Search. Alternatively do what the screenshot shows.

It is also available as a search option in Firefox.
